The problem (1)

A. MOUTH ULCERS open sores in the mouth






- About 20% of population suffers from mouth ulcers *
 - Mainly women: 56%, especially category 20-40 year
- **Causes:** physical abrasion, acidic fruit, infection, other medical condition, stress, medication, hormonal fluctuations,...

- B. DENTAL BRACES
- Irritate and abrade the cheeks and tongue
- Make cleaning of the teeth more difficult, resulting in elevated levels of bacteria in the mouth.

C. DENTURES: aging population \rightarrow dentures \uparrow


Denture stomatitis is a common oral mucosal lesion in the United States and Western Europe. Prevalence rates up to 18.3% in adults aged 65-74*












Barrier

- Application of irritants such as glucose or fruit juice (pH 3) on tested product
 - Apply Zoralan gel on semi-permeable wells with a receiver compartment
 - Put irritant on top of the gel barrier
 - Compare with controls such as water, PVP other gels
 - As a function of time, monitor the concentration of irritant in the receiver compartment




Measured glucose concentration (%) vs contact time (min)





Painless – Physiological


- Slug (Arion Iusitanicus) Mucosal Irritation Potency Test
 - placing the slugs (n=5) on undiluted test item for contact periods of 30 minutes for five successive days
 - measuring the amount of mucus produced
 - phosphate buffered saline is added near the foot of the slug
 - measure after each 30-min. contact period in PBS:
 - the protein and enzyme release (lactate dehydrogenase [LDH] and alkaline phosphatase [ALP]) from the body wall of the slugs
 - with some irritants there is an obvious flight reaction :







Results : Slug (Arion Iusitanicus) Mucosal Irritation Potency Test






Clinically Tested




